

1. Before each message meeting, there is a half-hour waiting time for the Lord. Please come early to prepare.

第一堂信息（周六晨间） 尼希米记第一至三章

尼希米的故事教导我们许多在当今世代需要实践的功课。尼希米心中全面的负担就是为了神的子民和神的国度。因着这一个负担，他必须努力工作、奋勇争战并不住祷告，才能完成神交付给他的使命。我们也必须学习去工作、争战和祷告，才能完成神对我们的心意。

尼希米记第一至三章：

- 一、尼希米在巴比伦的责任
- 二、他的工作虽在巴比伦，但他的心却与在耶路撒冷的神的子民同在
- 三、注意他对耶路撒冷神子民光景的反应
- 四、他开始祷告，我们也必须像尼希米一样，沉浸在祷告中作一切的事，并且是不住地祷告
- 五、重返耶路撒冷的神迹
- 六、亲眼目睹当地的情形
- 七、尼希米明白这项任务不是靠一个人可以完成的，他需要一个团队（教会），需要一群委身的人齐心协力一同来完成
- 八、每一个人都在自己的位置上同心建造，彼此配搭
- 九、敌对的声音立刻出现——从不满开始，接着是言语的攻击，并随着工程的进展而不断加剧
- 十、尼希米的回应：继续祷告，继续建造

Message I (Saturday morning):

The story of Nehemiah teaches many lessons that need to be applied in our day. His overall burden was for the people of God and for the kingdom of God. He needed to work, fight and pray in order to complete the task assigned to him by God. We also must learn to work, fight and pray to complete what God wants from us.

Text: Nehemiah chapters 1-3.

1. Nehemiah's responsibilities in Babylon.
2. His job was in Babylon but his heart was with the people of God in Jerusalem.
3. Notice his reaction to the condition of the people of God in Jerusalem.
4. He begins to pray. We must, like Nehemiah, bathe all we do in prayer. Pray without ceasing.
5. The miracle of getting back to Jerusalem.
6. Seeing the situation firsthand
7. Nehemiah realizes that the task is not going to be accomplished by one man. It will take a team (a church). It will need to be a coordinated and combined effort by a committed group of people.
8. Each one worked together and built right where they were.
9. The opposition was immediate. It starts with displeasure, moves to verbal attacks and continues to ramp up as the work progresses.
10. Nehemiah's response was to pray and continue to work.

第二堂信息（周六晚间） 尼希米记第四至六章

一、我们已经建造到一半，反对的力量却变得更加剧烈，但现在我们绝不能停工，虽然前面仍有漫长的路要走

二、一些核心同工感到疲惫不堪，甚至想要放弃

三、尼希米向他们说鼓励的话，借着神的灵，使众人重新得力，继续奋战与建造
——绝不回头

四、敌人持续不断地挑战，企图使尼希米停工，但都未能成功

五、尼希米为力量向神祷告

六、最终城墙建造完工，荣耀全归于神

安静等候主：收回游荡的心思，转向里面，主耶稣就在我们里面，祂和我们是那么近。注目仰望耶稣，单单亲近祂、积极等候祂、用全心爱祂…

诗 65:4 你所拣选，使他亲近你，住在你院中的，这人便为有福。我们必因你居所、
你圣殿的美福知足了。

Workshop (Saturday afternoon):

Text: I John 2

The thrust would be that Jesus is coming back and we want to be ready for Him when He returns. In order to be ready, we must remain (abide) in Him.

The problem is that we have an enemy that fights against us. Our only hope is keeping the anointing He has given us. That anointing will enable us to remain in Him so when He appears we'll be ready to receive Him with open arms.

Message II (Saturday evening):

Text: Nehemiah 4-6

1. We're at the halfway point. The opposition is becoming severe. We've gone too far to quit but we still have a long way to go.
2. Some of the key workers feel overwhelmed and are ready to quit.
3. Nehemiah speaks words of encouragement and by the Spirit of God the men are encouraged to continue to fight and work. No turning back!
4. The continued unsuccessful challenges to get Nehemiah to stop.
5. Nehemiah prays for strength.
6. The task is finished all to the glory of God.

第三堂（主日晨间） 创世记廿十二 1-14； 约翰福音 4:1-26； 罗马书 12:1

- 一、创世记第 22 章是圣经中第一次提到「敬拜」的地方，这里没有音乐，没有歌唱，只有一老一少两个人——教导我们圣经对敬拜的定义
- 二、这是一个关于顺服与降服的故事——完全地为祂放下一切
- 三、罗马书第 12 章告诉我们，因着认识并且回应神向着我们的怜悯而将自己全然献上，这就是属灵的敬拜
- 四、亚伯拉罕献上他最宝贵的一—他最爱的，以撒献上自己的生命，作为属灵的敬拜
- 五、我们若要成为真正的敬拜者，就是祂所寻找的那种人，我们不仅要放下那些我们不喜欢或不想要的，乃是愿意放下一切
- 六、约翰福音第 4 章是耶稣关于敬拜的教导：那位妇人所需要做的，就是将她的生命交给主，认识主对她的爱与怜悯，并完全地降服于祂。当她这样做时，她得着了前所未有的满足
- 七、我们每个人都要做出选择，我建议我们将一切都降服于祂，愿我们都成为真正的敬拜者，而不只是唱歌的人

Message III (Sunday morning):

Text: Genesis 22:1-14, John 4:1-26, Romans 12:1

1. Genesis 22 is the first mention of worship in the Bible. No music, no singing, two men, one young and one old teach us the Biblical definition of worship.
2. It's a story of obedience and surrender. Completely laying down everything for Him.
3. Romans 12 says giving our all in recognition and in response to His mercy towards us is our spiritual act of worship.
4. Abraham offered the best he had. That which he loved most. Isaac laid down his life as a spiritual act of worship.
5. We must not only give up the things we don't like or don't want but we must be willing to give up everything if we want to be true worshippers, the kind He seeks.
6. John 4 is a teaching Jesus gave on the subject of worship. What the woman needed to do was give her life up to Him. To realize His love and mercy towards her and to surrender completely to Him. As she did, she found fulfillment she never knew before.
7. We all have a choice to make. I suggest we surrender all to Him.

I suggest we all become true worshipers, not just singers.
